Contract term may be 1 to 3 years. All communication and billing will be directed to the Scott SWCD. Please provide an estimated cost for the treatment(s) listed below that you are able to provide. Contractor will be selected based on cost, experience, and availability during critical application periods. Strong consideration will also be given to the type of equipment that will be used, with particular emphasis on precision application and ensuring drift prevention. Quotes must be submitted to the Scott SWCD by March 1, 2025.
